B. Winter Projects

clean clubhouse — Logan has gone out to the Clubhouse a few times to clean inside. There are still seeds in the corner. 4 mice have been caught so far, but there is no noticeable new messes in the spots he has cleaned up. One of the fluorescent lights has been replaced with a LED one and the ballast was removed. The lights are more efficient and brighter than the old ones. With the power going up this summer, it was suggested that the other old ones be replaced. There are 3 more in the operating room, 2 in the generator room, and 1 in the porch. Logan reattached one of the lights to the ceiling. One of the front windows has a hole in the sill and needs repair, some wood may need replacing, some painting can be done, pest deterrent placed inside and planted outside, and the old shingles can be moved or removed. Logan will go there occasionally to clean and will update those interested in coming out when he is going in case others want to come out, too.

Reimbursement and replacement of additional lighting: Logan purchased a CO2 and smoke alarm as the old one was at end of life. He is requesting reimbursement for \$41.33. Logan also is requesting reimbursement for one LED light he replaced in the operating room, which was \$28.61. Don made a motion to reimburse Logan for the cost of the CO2/smoke alarms and LED light for a total of \$69.94. Bill L seconded. Motion passed. Bill made a motion to replace the lights in the control room (3), Don seconded, and motion passed.
